BNAPS to Celebrate the 60th Anniversary of the First Flight of the BN-1F



The first Britten-Norman aircraft, BN-1F G-ALZE, made its first official flight from Bembridge on 26 May 1951 piloted by Geoffrey Alington. Recognising the historic significance of the BN-1F BNAPS has arranged for a commemorative event to take place on Thursday 26 May 2011 at the Solent Sky Aviation Museum Southampton where the BN-1F is on public display.

B-N's first employee Peter Gatrell, whose first job was to construct the wooden airframe and most of the metal fittings for the BN-1F, will be present. A book about the BN-1F by Peter Gatrell and Bob Wealthy will be released for sale at the event.

Anyone who is interested in supporting the event and having a look around the museum is welcome to attend. Note that normal museum entry charges will apply. The plan is to meet up at Solent Sky around 11:30, there will be a few words and photographs alongside the BN-1F at 12:00, local press, TV and radio will be invited to cover the event.

Refurbishment of East Wight Workshop Nears Completion

New wing stands and a more substantial fuselage cradle have been made and were installed in early December. Building work to fit an enlarged access door to the workshop building has been completed. A water drainage gully has been repaired to prevent ingress of rain water that was causing a major problem. Quotations have been obtained for the new electrics and lighting installation and work is now underway.

The next task will be that of painting the floor, walls and roof and fitting out work benches, shelving, cupboards and a secure access storage area for controlled parts.
